The painter Clotilde Brewster Peploe was born in 1915, the daughter of Christopher Brewster, an American born in Austria, and Elizabeth von Hildebrand, also a painter born in Florence, and the fifth daughter of the German sculptor Adolph von Hildebrand.

During the 1930's Clotilde and her mother spent long months painting together in southern Italy, and later in Corfu and on mainland Greece. At the same time she became romantically attached to Willy Peploe, son of the Scottish Colourist, S.J. Peploe, whom she married in Athens in November 1939. This exhibition looks at Clotilde's work alongside those of her father-in-law - S.J. Peploe, brother-in-law – Dennis Peploe and other members of the Peploe family.
